

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS  
RESOLUTION NO. 82-2

A Resolution to declare the two decommissioned police cars surplus.

Whereas the two vehicles each particularly identified as 1974  
Ply Fury 4Dr PH41K4D206429 and as 1973 Dodge Pol 4D DM4103D285371  
are no longer useable by the Town of Granite Falls, and

Whereas such vehicles are surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls,

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Vehicle #1 1974 PLYFURY 4 Dr. PH41K4D206429 and vehicle  
#2 1973 Dodge POL 4DR DM4103D285371 are declared surplus.

Section 2: Said vehicles are to be sold to the highest bidder at a sealed bid opening.

Section 3: Said vehicles are to be sold "As is" with no warranty either expressed or implied as to completeness or suitability for any purpose whatsoever.

Section 4: Said vehicles to be available for public inspection during the regular Town Hall hours through the Clerk.

Section 5: Sealed bids to be given to the Town Clerk or mailed to the Town Clerk, at any rate to be received no later than <sup>NOON</sup> February 24, 1982.

Section 6: Sealed bids to be opened by the Mayor or Mayor Pro-Tem during the regular public Council meeting February 24, 1982.

Section 7: Winning bidder(s) shall present cash payment no later than 4 P.M. February 25, 1982 and shall remove the vehicles from Town property within 24 hours of payment.

Section 8: The Town treasurer shall release the titles to the winning bidder(s) upon satisfactory payment in cash.

Section 9: In the event the winning bidder cannot complete payment within the prescribed time, the next highest bidder shall become eligible.

Section 10: All sealed bids shall contain the bid amount, bidder(s) name, address, phone number and shall specify the amount for each vehicle individually.

Section 11: Any and all monies received shall be held for the police department of Granite Falls' vehicle contingency fund by the Treasurer until such fund is established by Ordinance.
