

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS

RESOLUTION NO. 92-9

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has received notification from the State Department of Community Development concerning the distribution of 1993 GMA funds; and

WHEREAS, said notification stated that the 1993 GMA funds would be available for distribution July 1992; and

WHEREAS, said notification stated that in order for the funds to be released to each County, sixty percent of the jurisdictions in the County representing seventy-five percent of the population must agree to the method of distribution; and

WHEREAS, said notification stated that the agreement from each jurisdiction must be by Council action; and

WHEREAS, said notification stated that monies must be distributed for GMA planning to small cities; and


WHEREAS, to date the GMA planning for the Town of Granite Falls has been through monies distributed to the Small Cities Consortium.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Granite Falls Town Council hereby approves the following motion at its Council Meeting of July 22, 1992.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Granite Falls' position on distribution of 1993 GMA funds should ensure continued funding of the Small Cities Consortium; of which the Town of Granite Falls is a member. Further the Town of Granite Falls recommends that a minimum of sixty thousand dollars from the 1993 GMA funds be distributed to the Small Cities Consortium for 1993 expenses.
