RESOLUTION NO. 94-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS ADOPTING
A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GROWTH MANAGEMENT ACT.

WHEREAS, the State requires that Snohomish County and cities within Snohomish County adopt a Comprehensive Plan in accordance with Section 36.70A.070 of the Growth Management Act; and

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls has completed a plan which addresses the concern for the natural environment, residential quality and other planning issues for the community for the next twenty years in conformance with the Snohomish County-Wide Planning Policies; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission and Council conducted a citizen's survey and held public meetings and public hearings throughout the entire process of developing a revised Comprehensive Plan; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS that the document consisting of the text and map entitled "City of Granite Falls Comprehensive Plan", hereto attached as Exhibit A, is adopted as the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Granite Falls.
