**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF GRANITE FALLS PRIORITIZING THE
APPLICATIONS FOR CONSERVATION FUTURES
FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, funding is available from Snohomish County Conservation Futures Program for eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls is submitting two projects of importance;

WHEREAS, it is required that the City Council of Granite Falls prioritize their projects;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Granite Falls the applications for Conservation Futures Funds shall be prioritized as follows:

- 1. Lake Gardner Park - request in the amount of \$340,000.00.**
- 2. Noble Bog Interpretive Park - request in the amount of \$70,000.00.**

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls on the 25 day of September, 1996.
