

CITY OF GRANITE FALLS

RESOLUTION NO. 97-6

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls is proposing vacation of the alley located in Block 5 of the Original Townsite of Granite Falls. The location of the alley is more particularly described as lying between Galena and Union Streets (on the North and South) and Portage and Prospect Avenues (on the West and East).

WHEREAS, the City Council declare that the alley is not necessary as a part of the general road system and the public will not be inconvenienced by its vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the City of Granite Falls is proposing vacation of the 13' alley in Block 5, Original Townsite of Granite Falls, more particularly described as lying between Galena and Union Streets (on the North and South) and Portage and Prospect Avenues (on the West and East).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the city of Granite Falls that a PUBLIC HEARING shall be held on October 22, 1997, at the Granite Falls City Hall, Council Chambers, 206 South Granite Avenue, Granite Falls, Washington, to hear all public comment concerning the proposed alley vacation.
