RESOLUTION NO. 07-05

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council that the City of Granite Falls that a PUBLIC HEARING shall be held on October 17, at 8:00PM, at the Granite Falls City Hall, Council Chambers, 206 South Granite Avenue, Granite Falls, Washington, to hear all public comment concerning the proposed avenue vacation.
