City of Conroe- Curbside Garbage Collection

CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION

Please have your waste out by 6:30 a.m. on your service day.

Household garbage and yard waste are collected at the curb and limited to the 96-gallon Waste Management cart with the green lid per collection.

If you have extra trash, please purchase an Extra Service Tag from City of Conroe Utility Department and then place 1-tag per 1-bag and Waste Management will service it on your service day. If you need an extra cart, please contact City of Conroe Utility Department to setup.

BULK TRASH COLLECTION

Bulk collection will be once-a-month with a limit of 8 cu. yd. Collection will be at the curb, on Wednesday (see map on Bulk Waste Info page) once-a-month.

Please see description of Bulk Waste below:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Carpeting (cut into 4-foot bundles)
- Household furniture
- Appliances with CFCs removed
- Moving boxes (broken down and bundled)
- Oversized waste customary to normal household operations

Moving boxes are recyclable if they are cut and placed in recycling cart.

Please note! WM can no longer dispose of CFC refrigerant containing items (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.)

Brush-For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we do require that branches and tree trimmings be no greater than three inches (3") in diameter and be cut, tied and bundled in four foot (4') lengths weighing no more than forty to fifty pounds (40-50 lbs.) No containers over 45 gallons.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Appliances containing CFCs
- Gasoline
- TV'S
- Paint
- Batteries
- Tires
- Vehicles and parts
- Concrete, brick, asphalt and roofing
- Large pieces of metal
- Motor oil (and used filters)
- Construction debris

No household waste allowed during BULK collection.

All unacceptable items that are tagged (with green tags) must be removed and properly disposed of at a landfill or other facility.

HOLIDAYS

Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day
New Year's Day

Any observed holiday falling on a Monday through Friday will cause all subsequent service days for the week to be delayed by one day. For example, if Friday is an observed holiday, service will occur on Saturday.

- 🍃 Please have your recycling cart at the curb by 6:30 AM.
- 🍃 Place only acceptable recyclables shown below together in your recycling cart- no sorting needed.
- 🍃 Containers should be rinsed and free of food and liquid.
- 🍃 Do not put recyclables in plastic bags.

Recycling will be collected weekly on the same day your waste is collected. Acceptable materials for curbside recycling include:

Junk mail, office & school paper, phone books, books, catalogs, magazines & newspapers



Plastic bottles & containers



Glass bottles & jars



Chipboard, box board, brown paper bags & cardboard



Tin & aluminum cans



Paper cardboard, dairy & juice containers

Recycle correctly

Do NOT recycle the following:



No food waste and liquids



No plastic wraps or bags



No foam products

Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris.
 Paper food containers must be rinsed out- no caps.
 Tissues, paper towels, and other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.
 Make sure food contamination is removed from cans and plastics- all containers should be empty.
 Keep medical waste (syringes and needles) out of the recycling container.
