PLEASE RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

ITEM ☺	INCLUDES	PREPARATION
ALUMINUM	All beverage cans.	Make sure all containers are empty and rinsed out.
STEEL OR TIN CANS	All steel, tin or bi-metal food cans, empty paint cans.	Food cans must be empty and rinsed out.
PLASTIC BOTTLES	Include soda, water and liquor bottles.	Empty bottles, rinse them.
PLASTIC HOUSE-HOLD BOTTLES .	Includes detergent and personal care bottles, like shampoo; coffee containers	Rinse containers
PLASTIC JUGS	Includes milk jugs and water jugs.	Rinse jugs.

PAPER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newspaper Catalogs (soft cover books) Brown Paper Bags Chipboard (cereal and shoe boxes, etc.) Computer Paper Egg Cartons Envelopes Fax Paper Hard Cover Books with Covers Removed Junk Mail Magazines Manila Envelopes Office Paper Shredded Paper (bagged) Telephone Books White or Colored Paper

CARD-BOARD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Double Walled Boxes Clean boxes only Remove all tape and staples Flatten the boxes

ITEM	UNACCEPTABLE ☹
GLASS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2025 GLASS BOTTLES AND CONTAINERS WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED. RESIDENTS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR TOWNS DIRECTIVE ON GLASS DISPOSAL .

METAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aerosol Cans Propane tanks Aluminum foil, cookware, pie plates Aluminum flashing/siding

ITEM	UNACCEPTABLE ☹
PAPER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Milk Cartons Food and Meat Wrappers Waxed Paper Foil Gift Wrap Carbon Paper

ITEM	UNACCEPTABLE ☹
CARD-BOARD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Waxed, dirty or oily boxes. Take out Pizza boxes
LARD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No Shortening ; Crisco

ITEM	UNACCEPTABLE ☹
PLASTICS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Yogurt containers Plastic cups/utensils Pill bottles Rigid plastics (toys, buckets, furniture) Tupperware Plastic bags Nothing over 2 1/2 Gallons in size

ITEM	CAUTION 🧤
OIL /ANTI-FREEZE CONTAINERS	No containers that contained hazardous waste, oil, anti-freeze.
HAZARDOUS PRODUCT CONTAINERS	Check with your Town's Transfer Station Operator to see if your Town sponsors a Hazardous Waste Day.
