Subject **Award Recommendation for Sodium Hypochlorite Tanks**

---

The Water Treatment Plant uses onsite generation to make the disinfectant sodium hypochlorite (bleach). The product is stored in two tanks. The tanks were originally installed in 2007. One tank failed 2015 and was replaced with a fiberglass tank due to issues finding a tank that would be able to go through the door opening. At this point both tanks have experienced leaking with the fiberglass tank currently leaking. Both are in need of replacement and \$40,000 was budgeted for 2025 to replace both tanks.

Bid documents were prepared, the bid advertised, and individual possible vendors of this type of equipment were notified of the bid. Bids were opened on December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025 at 2:00 pm. Two bids were received: One from Core-Rosion Products and one from Technology International, Inc. The bid for Core-Rosion Products contained multiple tank options, some of which did not meet specifications. The bid from Technology International, Inc. had one set of tanks.

The bids were carefully evaluated and dimensions verified. The option that will work in our application from Core-Rosion Products is \$15,299.00 and exceeds the warranty specification. The bid from Technology International, Inc that meets the specifications is \$22,490.00.

We recommend awarding to bid for the sodium hypochlorite tanks to Core-Rosion Products in the amount of \$15,299.00.
