Re: Award Bid for Chemical Controllers

Controllers provide continuous monitoring of water quality at the complex. The current BECSys3 model chemical controllers at the aquatic complex work intermittently and have become unreliable.

The proposed controllers will be the BECSys5 model will create reliability and efficiency in water quality at the pool. Also new controllers include additional technological benefits. Parks personnel will install the new controllers. See bid results below.
