Re: Award Bid for Woodbury Fencing

A section of chain link fence on Trapper Field at Woodbury Sports Complex has failed in numerous areas and has become unrepairable in addition to causing a safety hazard to players.

The proposed fencing project is installing 270' black vinyl coated chain link that will match the existing baseball backstop fencing material. An additional bid option of a bottom rail was included in the bid. The preferred start date would be prior to Parks & Recreation spring programming but also weather dependent.

During the competitive bid process there were several inquiries regarding the project. A total of six vendors submitted bids for the project. See attached tab sheet for reference.

I would recommend the city council approve the Woodbury Fencing bid to Ivory Tip Fencing that includes the additional bid option in the amount of \$10,708.80. The approved budget for the project is \$12,400.
