Subject: Purchase of John Deere 1600 Commercial Mower through Sourcewell

Staff are seeking City Council approval to purchase a John Deere 1600 Commercial Mower to replace the 2016 currently in service. The new mower will be acquired through Sourcewell, a cooperative purchasing program that provides access to competitively bid national contracts and reduced pricing due to volume inventory.

The City of Craig will work directly with U.S. Tractor & Harvest, a local participating Sourcewell vendor. The quoted price of \$74,711.84 includes the mower and Power Guard Protection Plan of 48 months. This plan would include everything but consumables (tires, fluids, etc.) with a zero-dollar deductible.
