A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN THE SOLID WASTE FUND FOR SINGLE USE BAG FEE COLLECTIONS

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 14) provides for the appropriation of excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted the 2025 Annual Appropriation Ordinance #1154 and Carryover Ordinance #1163; and

WHEREAS, HB 21-1162 states the single use bag fee collections must be used towards recycling efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2025 Budget to appropriate single use bag fee collections towards a 1500 gallon used oil recycle tank;

AND WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$20,450 of single use bag fee collections towards the purchase of a 1500 Gallon Used Oil Recycle Tank (70-67-94700).

We are requesting the reappropriation of \$20,450 in funds currently collected through the plastic bag fee. As stipulated, these funds can only be used for recycling-related expenses. We are proposing to allocate these funds to the Solid Waste Department for the purchase of a new used oil recycling tank.

Although the used oil tank is already approved in the 2025 budget, the \$20,450 from the plastic bag fee will help offset costs, reducing the financial burden on the Solid Waste Department. We believe this reallocation of funds is a practical and efficient use of the plastic bag fee revenue.
