1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,004 requests for service during the month of December. Community Service responded to 98 requests for service.

This month, we investigated several thefts from vehicles, shoplifting complaints and theft of packages from porches - tis the season for this type of theft.

Most of the thefts from vehicles can be classified as crimes of opportunity. Most of the reported thefts were from vehicles that were not locked and valuable items were left inside the vehicle. In one case, there was a small amount of cash taken and in another case a firearm was taken from unlocked vehicles. There were other vehicles that were entered, but nothing was taken.

We had a large increase in the theft of packages from front porches. This type of theft is not only a local problem; as this type of crime was highly covered on the Denver media outlets during the Christmas season.


