

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 26, 2018
MINUTES with AMENDMENTS

Mayor John Ponikvar brought to order at 6:30 p.m. the second regular meeting of the Craig City Council for the month of June 2018. In addition to Mayor Ponikvar, those present were Councilmembers Tony Bohrer, Derek Duran, Joe Bird, Jarrod Ogden and Chris Nichols. Councilwoman Andrea Camp was absent. Staff present were Acting City Manager/Finance Director Bruce Nelson, City Attorney Sherman Romney, Chief of Police Jerry Delong, Water/Wastewater IT/Maintenance Specialist Carl Ray, Public Works Director Randy Call, Parks/Recreation Director Dave Pike, Building Inspector Marlin Eckhoff and Deputy City Clerk Liz White.

All participated in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Bird moved with a second by Councilman Ogden to approve the minutes from the June 12, 2018, meeting. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Councilman Bohrer moved with a second by Councilman Bird to approve the agenda as presented. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Councilman Duran moved with a second by Councilman Nichols to approve the Consent Agenda which included the renewal of a tavern liquor license for Mathers' Bar Inc., dba Mathers' located at 420 Yampa Avenue, Craig. No cause shown for denial. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Chad Paulson from SGM gave council and staff and audience members an update of the projects and engineering services they are doing for the city of Craig. He specified that the next scheduled update would take place sometime in September.

Building Inspector Eckhoff brought before council a Conditional Use Permit application for Esther and Kyle York, dba Tiny Tots Childcare, located at 2929 Pinon Circle, Craig. The Conditional Use permit would give the business, which is a home-based childcare facility for up to six (6) children, the ability to become a licensed child care facility for more than six (6) but less than twelve (12) children which is listed under conditional uses in a Residential Low Density District. The floor was opened up for the Conditional Use Public Hearing in which there was no public comment. After a brief discussion and after receiving a recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission, Councilman Ogden moved with a second by Councilman Bohrer to approve the Conditional Use Permit for Esther and Kyle York, dba Tiny Tots Childcare, located at 2929 Pinon Circle, Craig. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried. The permit will be reviewed in a year at which that time it would be renewable for possibly a longer period than one year.

Water/Wastewater IT/Maintenance Specialist Ray reviewed the May 2018 reports for both the water and wastewater departments and answered any questions council had.

Acting City Manager Nelson gave his city manager and financials reports for the month of May 2018.

Parks & Recreation Director Pike introduced Charlie Carroll as the new aquatics manager for the city of Craig. He also gave council, staff and citizens an update on this year's Whittle the Wood event. All felt the event was well received by the public and that it was a huge success.

During audience comments citizen Ken Wergin commented on various topics.

City Attorney Romney had nothing to report.

Following some brief reports and comments by Council, Councilman Bohrer moved with a second by Councilman Ogden to retire to executive session. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Following their return to open session, Councilman Ogden moved with a second by Councilman Bohrer to adjourn the meeting. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried.
