SUBJECT: Activity Report – December 2018

#### 1. Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 962 requests for service during the month of December. Community Service responded to 89 requests for service.

Once again, this month officers contacted several individuals for miscellaneous violations that resulted in the individuals being arrested for drug related crimes. The majority of the crimes are associated with methamphetamine and methamphetamine drug paraphernalia.

Officers also arrested nine individuals for warrants and investigated four driving under the influence incidents this month.

Officers responded to three calls of counterfeit \$100. A suspect was identified in one case. He was interviewed and charged accordingly.
