Bids were opened on February 19, 2020 for an infield groomer that will be utilized at Woodbury Park to maintain our baseball infields. The infield groomer will replace our Little Rascal drag that became inoperable last season.

We sent out four bids for this piece of equipment. Potestio Brothers Equipment submitted bids for two different models. A Smithco Sand Star II in the amount of \$18,542.99 and a John Deere, 1200 Hydro in the amount of \$17,461. LL Johnson submitted one bid for a Toro Infield Pro 3040 for \$18,127.

The budgeted amount for the infield groomer was \$19,000. At this time, I recommend the City of Craig purchase the John Deere 1200 Hydro infield groomer in the amount of \$17,461 which was low bid.
