### 1. Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 876 requests for service during the month of February. Community Service responded to 83 requests for service.

We are continuing to patrol the school zones and bus stops for violations.

As I stated last month, we are still having vehicles entered and items taken from the vehicles. These vehicles were not locked during the thefts.

Three vehicles were reported stolen this month. All three of the vehicles were recovered within a short period of time. In two of the vehicle thefts, the keys were in the vehicle; and in the third case, the person had access to the keys.

This month we made 15 warrant arrests.
