A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO CARRYOVER BUDGETED 2019 PROJECTS OR COMMITMENTS NOT ACCOMPLISHED IN 2019 INTO THE 2020 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted the 2020 Annual Appropriation Ordinance #1102; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2020 Budget to complete the following projects or commitments:

- (a.) To increase Capital Outlay Council budget in the General Fund for the completion of the following items: opportunity zone prospectus (\$9,500), Craig Business and Technology Incubator (\$20,900), Wayfinding project (\$37,800), and the Recreation District Study (\$25,000);
- (b.) To increase Capital Outlay Public Works budget in the General Fund to replace a computer (\$4,500);
- (c.) To increase the Community Development budget in the General Fund for blighted properties (\$19,200);
- (d.) To increase the Police budget in the General Fund for the replacement of computers (\$5,500);
- (e.) To increase the Park budget in the General Fund for the completion of the Breeze Park Project (\$68,490) and grant for developing APP for trails (\$8,500);
- (f.) To increase Capital Outlay Road & Bridge in the General Fund budget for the following items: replace 3 computers (\$5,000), snow removal (\$2,600) and beautification project for sidewalks and landscaping (\$45,000);
- (g.) To transfer funds from General Fund to the Capital Project Fund for the city cost of US 40 sidewalk project (\$291,000);
- (h.) To increase Capital Project Fund budget for the following projects: US 40 Sidewalk project (\$276,350), and curb/gutter replacement (\$50,000);
- (i.) To increase the Water Fund budget for the following items: Water System upgrade/Chloramines Improvements - construction (\$1,202,000) and engineering (\$147,200), purchase of a Vac/Hotsy pressure washer/valve turner trailer (\$57,095), and rebuild of a high service pump (\$30,000);
- (j.) To increase the Wastewater Fund budget for sludge line replacement design (\$86,570), and purchase of a high crop tractor (\$120,000).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>RECOGNITION OF ADDITIONAL REVENUES</u>. There are unrestricted and unappropriated surplus funds in the General Fund in the amount of \$542,990 with offsetting grants and fund of \$97,150, the Capital Project Fund in the amount of \$326,350, the Water Fund in the amount of \$1,437,185 with offsetting grants of \$391,500, and the Wastewater Fund in the amount of \$206,570 be appropriated and be made available for said purposes.

Section 2. <u>SPECIFIC ACCOUNT MODIFICATIONS</u>. That the Budget, as adopted in the 2020 Annual Appropriation Ordinance, shall be amended as follows:
