4. Investigations – Detective Sergeant Marvin Cameron

Major case investigation - First Degree Assault On the evening of March 17, 2020 Craig Police Officers responded to the Regional Memorial Hospital for a male that was being treated for multiple stab wounds.

Patrol Officer Hashir interviewed a witness to the assault. Detectives Rimmer and Cameron responded and assisted in this investigation. Probable cause was developed and Det. Rimmer was able to secure an arrest warrant for a male resident of Craig as well as two search warrants.

On March 18, 2020 a male suspect was arrested for the assault and taken into custody without incident. The two search warrants were executed and yielded valuable evidence that will be used in any future prosecution.

This investigation was truly a team effort between the Patrol Division, Detective Division and the Moffat County Special Response Team who assisted with the arrest and execution of the search warrants.
