Future of EMS Moffat County



- Last meeting all 3 entities stated that we need to look at a Mill Levy to sustain EMS services in Moffat County.
- Mill Levy
 - Currently 1 Mill = \$413,210
 - Need to take into consideration the future of Moffat County and the projected loss of large businesses and tax dollars
 - Cost of EMS Services for the year of 2019 = \$1,082,413
 - Overall loss for EMS Services for the year of 2019 = \$681,943
- Contacted Paul Wisor Attorney out of Eagle that has worked with Dr. Elise Sullivan on the Rec District.
 - o Advice
 - Go for the Mill Levy in March or November 2021
 - Time to prepare and accurately map out district
 - Potentially form EMS district have its own governing body and Board of Directors or fall under one of the 4 entities participating in meetings
 - Cost Total \$60-70K
 - Attorney Fees \$40K
 - Map out district
 - Determine the best way to structure EMS
 - EMS District
 - Formation of a Board
 - Process to get a Mill Levy on the Ballot
 - Service Plan must be approved by County
 - Court has to approve the service plan to get on the ballot

 - Deadline to get all paperwork turned in for ballot
