Resolution No. 12 (2020)

A RESOLUTION SHOWING SUPPORT FOR THE STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT DEFINING PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE EXECUTION OF THE YAMPA SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR THE 400 & 500 BLOCKS OF YAMPA AVENUE AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR OGDEN TO EXECUTE THE FINAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CRAIG AND THE STATE OF COLORADO.

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §43-2-104.5 permits the State to contract with Local Agencies to provide maintenance and construction of highways that are part of the state (or local agency) highway system.

WHEREAS, the City of Craig and the State have agreed that they will engage in a joint project repair of the 400 and 500 blocks of Yampa Avenue between 4th and 6th street. The parties agree they will remove and replace 2,485 square yards of concrete sidewalk and 1,320 linear feet of curb and gutter. The parties agree as part of this project they will replace electrical lighting infrastructure, remove or remediate trees that create subsurface issues for the infrastructure and replace trees with ADA grates where necessary.

WHEREAS, the total cost of Work for the project is determined to be \$505,795.00; the State shall be responsible for \$308,535.00 (61% of participating costs) and the City of Craig shall be responsible for \$197,260.00 (39% of participating costs). The City of Craig shall be 100% responsible for all non-participating costs. In the event that the total cost of work is less than \$505,795.00 the amounts paid by the City of Craig and the State will be decreased in accordance with the funding ratio listed above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in the City of Craig in the County of Moffat that the City Council approves the Contract for Project MTF M255-007 (23831) for the Yampa Avenue Sidewalks and authorizes the Mayor to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City of Craig.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this Resolution shall take effect upon adoption, shall be authenticated, and shall be numbered and recorded in the official records of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if any provision of this Resolution or the application of it to any person or circumstances is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications. The provisions of this resolution are expressly declared to be severable.
