1. Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 1,346 requests for service during the month of August. Community Service responded to 155 requests for service.

School is back in session and we have focused patrols in the school zones. The first few days of school at the Middle School and Sandrock Elementary were congested with traffic. Officers ended up directing traffic the first two days of school. Each day of the first week of school, the flow of traffic continued to improve.

This month we continued to handle several theft complaints. Most of the thefts were from vehicles and shoplifting.

Major Case of month

On the evening hours of August 30, 2020 Craig Police Officers were called to Regional Memorial Hospital for a report that a male party had been stabbed twice in the back and once in the back of his elbow. Officer's investigation revealed the stabbing occurred in a residence in the City of Craig. Craig Police Officers determined that an adult female from Craig was responsible and was arrested and booked into the Moffat County Jail. The male is expected to fully recover.

- ✓ *A sex assault on a child was reported to the Craig Police Department. Investigation was initiated by Hayden Police Department and determined to have occurred in Craig.*
- ✓ *Another law enforcement agency forwarded an Internet Sexual Exploitation of a Child Investigation to the Craig Police Department. Case is currently on-going.*
- ✓ *Investigated an apparent suicide; 33-year-old male.*
- ✓ *I assisted patrol officers with the recovery of suspected stolen property from Steamboat Springs and the Town of Hayden. Additional property was also recovered but may have not been reported as stolen. This investigation lead to Steamboat Springs Police Department obtaining a search warrant for a residence in Craig and additional stolen property was recovered. A suspect has been identified and an arrest warrant is forth coming from multiple jurisdictions. The suspect is suspected of breaking into multiple storage units in Routt and Moffat County.*

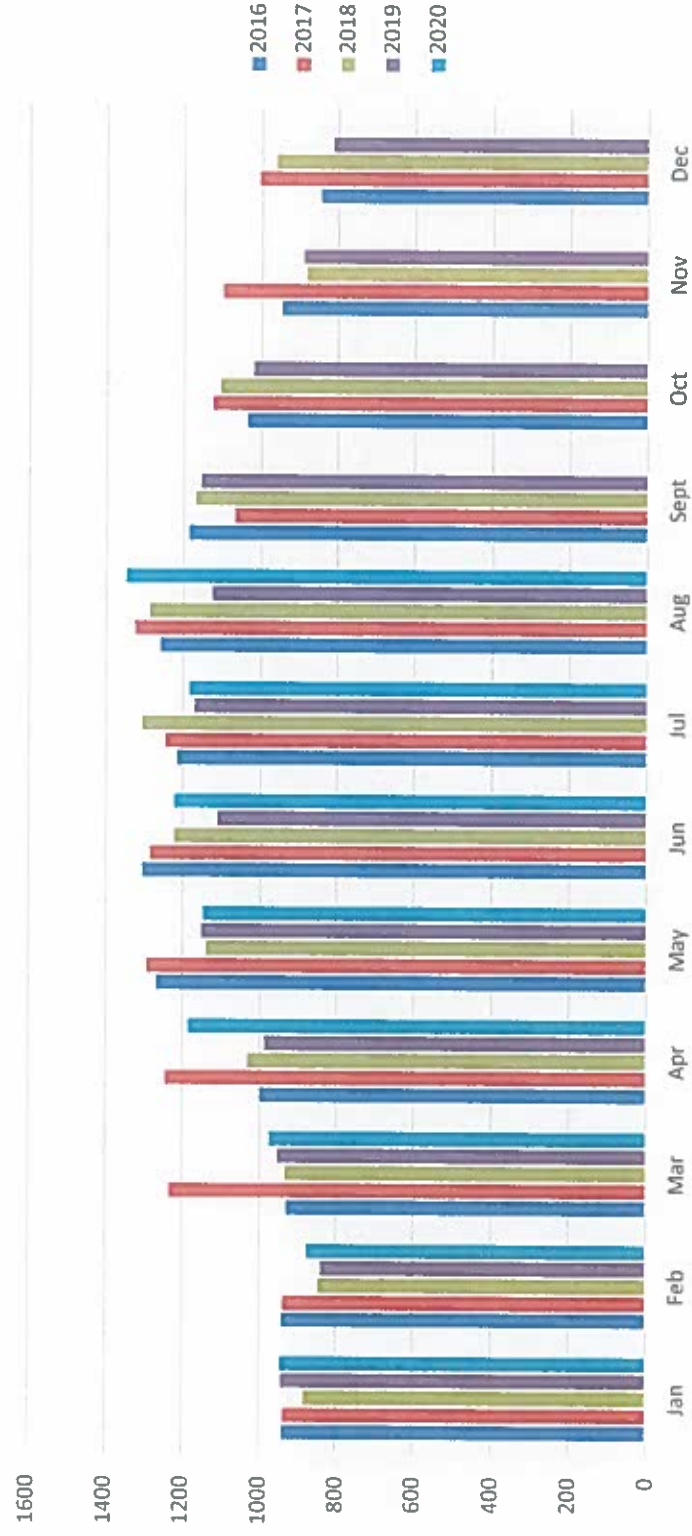
