RESOLUTION No. 14 (2020)

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS INTO THE GENERAL FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR ELIGIBLE CORONAVIRUS RELATED EXPENSES

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 15) provides for the appropriating of excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City has received additional revenues from the Coronavirus Relief Funds that are unappropriated in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2020 Budget to provide for funds for eligible coronavirus related expenses;

AND WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado that unappropriated revenues from the Coronavirus Relief Funds in the amount of \$446,688.00 in the General Fund is hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes, and that the 2020 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is amended in the General Fund under Capital Projects – Council (10-41-96300) is hereby increased from \$0 to \$446,688.00 for eligible coronavirus related expenses.
