1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,288 requests for service during the month of September. Community Service responded to 111 requests for service.

The patrol division had another busy month handling calls for service. School zones are being patrolled during the drop off and pick up times to provide a safe environment for the children.

This month several individuals were arrested for possession of a controlled substance and were charged accordingly. We also were able to arrest and file charges on two individuals for breaking into storage facilities in Craig.


