

RESOLUTION No. 16 (2020)

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE MUSEUM FUND TO
PROVIDE FUNDS FOR A WATERCOLOR MURAL

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 15) provides for the appropriating of excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City has received additional revenues from the Local Marketing District for a watercolor mural that are unappropriated in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2020 Budget to provide for funds for a watercolor mural; and

AND WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado that the unrestricted and unappropriated excess revenues in the Museum Fund in the amount of \$28,000.00 is hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes, and that the 2020 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is amended in the Museum Fund under Other Improvements (29-83-93500) is hereby increased from \$0.00 to \$28,000.00 for a watercolor mural.
