1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,096 requests for service during the month of October. Community Service responded to 97 requests for service.

We continue to provide extra patrols in the school zones and are watching random buses for school bus “stop” signs violations as time allows.

The trend of increasing illegal drug charges continued this month. Several more individuals were charged with possession of schedule I or II drugs after being contacted for warrants, traffic and other crimes.

At the end of October, we experienced our first major snow storm of the season that resulted in winter driving conditions. This resulted in an increase in traffic crashes for a few days as drivers adapted back to slick roadways.

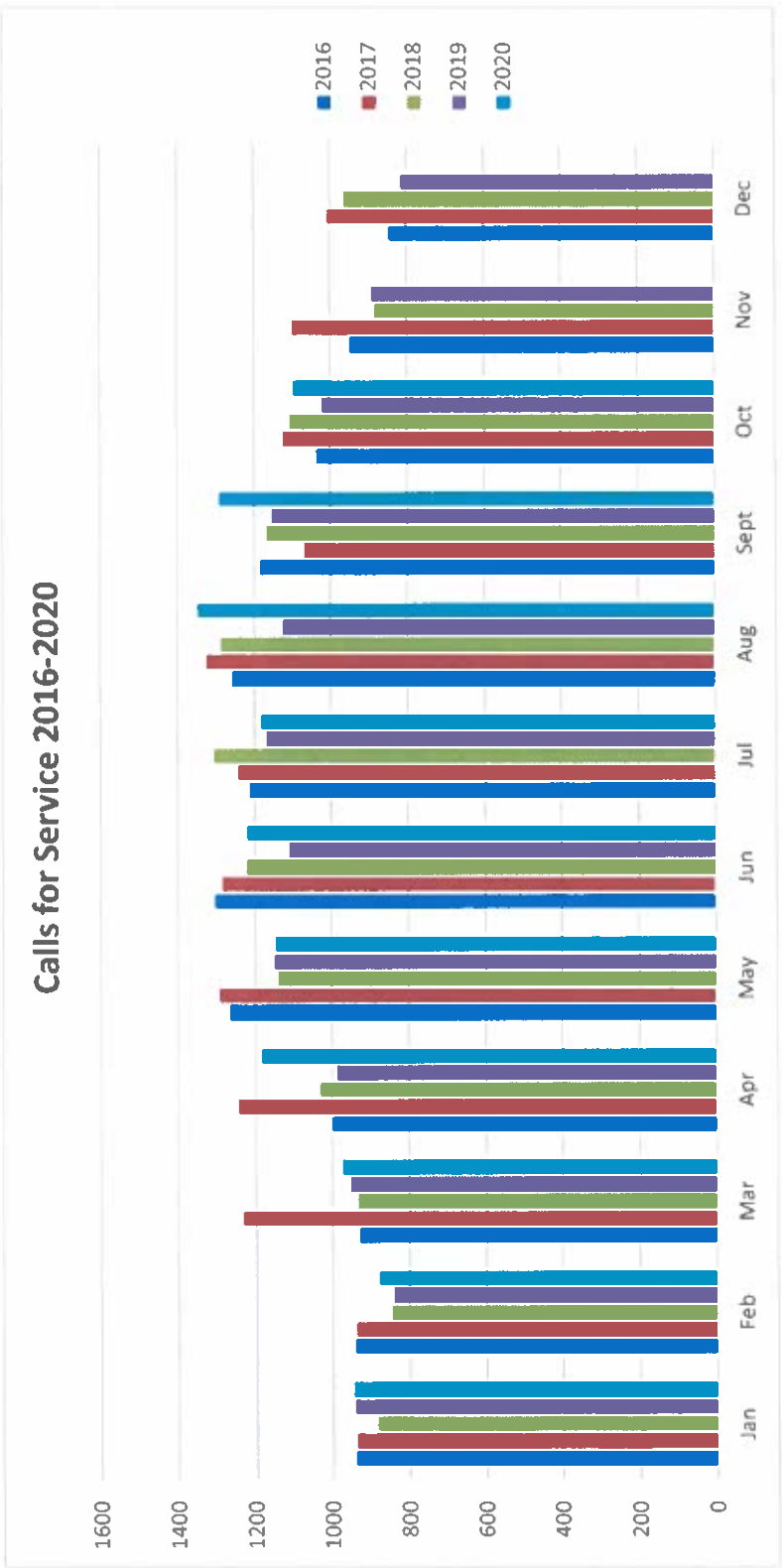
