1. Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 992 requests for service during the month of November. Community Service responded to 85 requests for service.

This month, I want to highlight that the City of Craig is no different than the rest of the United States when it comes to reported domestic violence cases. Throughout this pandemic, there has been an increase in domestic violence in our nation. This month, we responded to over 20 calls for domestic violence reports. Out of those reported cases, there were 12 cases that the officers completed reports. Eight individuals were arrested on domestic related charges and taken to jail. The other four cases were sent to the DA's Office for review and possible follow-up investigation by Daron Hashir.

Crime and Patrol Summary

See Attachments. The department responded to 1282 requests for service during the month of December. Community Service responded to 83 requests for service.

Theft from vehicles picked up near the end of the month. There were items taken in some of the car prowls. Some of the vehicles were just entered and nothing was taken. The Majority of these vehicles were unlocked at the time of the crime.

On the same note, we investigated several retail thefts (shoplifting) from our local businesses. In most of the incidents an individual was charged with the theft. Surveillance systems in the businesses are a great aid in helping identify the individuals and their vehicles.
