Crime and Patrol Summary

See Attachments. The department responded to 1013 requests for service during the month of December. Community Service responded to 32 requests for service.

This month we were busy handling Domestic Violence calls for service. Officers documented 8 cases of reported Domestic Violence. The majority of these calls resulted in arrests of suspects. Several of the suspects were arrested for violation of temporary restraining orders or assault.

We also saw an increase in traffic related violations including DUI, mis-use of license plates and two cases of vehicular eluding.
