

RESOLUTION No. 10 (2021)

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE WATER FUND TO ALLOW
FOR REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF OLD CONCRETE PLACED ON TOP OF A 20" WATER
TRANSMISSION MAIN

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 15) provides for the appropriating of excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City has excess revenues that are unrestricted and unappropriated in the Water Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2021 Budget to provide for funds for the removal of concrete that is located on top of a water main; and

WHEREAS, the expenditure was originally budgeted in the 2021 Budget General Fund instead of the Water Fund; and

AND WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado that the unrestricted and unappropriated excess revenues in the Water Fund in the amount of \$28,000.00 is hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes, and that the 2021 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is amended in the Water Fund under Improvements-Other (50-65-93500) is hereby increased from \$480,000.00 to \$508,000.00 for the removal of the concrete pile performed by Anson Excavating.
