A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AGNC'S LETTER TO THE COLORADO INDEPENDENT CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING COMMISSION AND ADVOCATING FOR SUSTAINING THE LARGE RURAL CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS EXISTING IN EASTERN AND WESTERN COLORADO

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado, that we find it valuable to support AGNC and Club 20 in their efforts to ensure that the Western Slope of Colorado has a voice in the Congressional redistricting process, and future elections.
