RESOLUTION No. 25 (2021)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CRAIG APPROVING THE USE OF ARPA FUNDING FOR COMPENSATION, BENEFITS, HOUSING, MEALS, TRANSPORTATION AND TUITION REQUIRED TO PROVIDE FOR 4 CADETS TO OBTAIN P.O.S.T. CERTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 14) provides for appropriating excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted the 2022 Annual Appropriation Ordinance #1126; and

WHEREAS, the City is responding to provisions within the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) that allow for the filling of vacancies for Public Safety personnel by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to authorize the use of \$266,143.00 of ARPA Funding received in 2021 in the 2022 Fiscal Budget for Cadet expenses to attend the Flat Rock POST Certification Training Program in Arapahoe County and the Colorado Mountain College Academy in Glenwood Springs, CO; and

WHEREAS, the City 2022 adopted budget had accounted for some of the payroll and related costs associated with the new Cadets and training; and

WHEREAS, the City will track all expenditures, including ARPA funded expenses through the City's Finance Department accounting system for the purpose of accurate accounting and annual audit verification; and

WHEREAS, this funded action has been determined necessary and needed to demonstrate ongoing support for the City of Craig's Police Department with the methods of funding not reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado that unappropriated revenues from the American Rescue Plan Act in the amount of \$266,143.00 be hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes, and that the 2022 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is amended in the General Fund Budget Expenses for eligible ARPA related expenses as follows:

Police Uniforms (10-51-22500)	\$7,890.00
Police Training/Education (10-51-38100)	\$23,800.00

The above amounts are hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes and will be added to the 2022 Annual Appropriation Ordinance as stated above. Remaining expenditures from the \$266,143 of this funding were already incorporated into the budget at time of original adoption.
