

ORDINANCE NO. 1141 (2023)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1 CHAPTER 1.08.010 OF THE CRAIG MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCLUDE USEFUL PUBLIC SERVICE AS A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE CRAIG MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the City of Craig is a home rule municipality;

WHEREAS, the Craig Municipal Code (“Code”) defines penalties for violations of any ordinance of the City;

AND WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to allow for certain violations of the Code to be subject to the completion of Useful Public Service Hours by any Juvenile and/or Defendant;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CRAIG, COLORADO:

Section 1. Title 1 Section 1.08.010 of the Craig Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.08.010 Designated.

- A. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of any ordinance of the city, except in those cases where a different punishment is prescribed by a specific ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and/or by imprisonment not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days, ~~or by both such fine and imprisonment.~~ and/or be required to perform useful public service not to exceed forty-eight (48) hours or any combination thereof.
- B. Each such person shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provisions of the ordinances of the city is committed, continued or permitted by any such person, and he or she shall be punished accordingly.

Section 2. If any subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance. All other provisions of Title 1 of the Craig Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. The City Council deems it appropriate to publish the title of this ordinance, together with a summary of the ordinance and with a statement that the text is available for public inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.

Section 5. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the City's authority to act under its police power to protect and preserve the general welfare of the City and its citizens.
