Re: Award Bid for Woodbury Park – Design Build Baseball Backstops

Bids were recently opened for the Woodbury Park - Design Build Baseball Backstops on March 22. There were four competitive bid packets that were received. Hill Construction, AJI Fencing, Ideal Fencing and Ivory Tip Fencing.

The extent of this project is to replace and install new baseball backstops on United Way and Jake's Fields. These two backstops have become degraded over the course of several years along with safety and maintenance issues increasing. Last year, Trapper Field backstop was replaced at the end of the season and has made an immediate impact on the ball fields.

I would recommend City Council award the bid for the Woodbury Park – Design Build Baseball Backstops to Ivory Tip Fencing in the amount of \$57,137.72 as they are low bid. The approved budget amount for the project is \$65,000.
