

RESOLUTION No. 11 (2023)

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE GENERAL FUND-
ADMINISTRATION FOR THE RURAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY ASSESSMENT PROJECT FOR
\$50,000

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 14) provides for the appropriating of excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted the 2023 Annual Appropriation Ordinance #1135, and Resolutions 5(2023), 7(2023), 9(2023), and 10(2023); and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded \$40,000 from CDOT in grant funding and \$10,000 in matching funds from Steamboat Ski and Resort Corporation for the funding of the RTA assessment project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2023 Budget to provide for additional funding in the Administration Department for the RTA project; and

AND WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado that the unrestricted and unappropriated excess revenues in the General Fund in the amount of \$50,000 are hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes, and that the 2023 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is amended in the General Fund – Administration Projects Miscellaneous (10-44-96100) account is increased from \$0 to \$50,000.
