I remember seeing this pump during my teens and was always fascinated by the old pumps. The pump was located on the Beckett place off Co. Rd. 15, in Moffat County, Colorado.

Leon Fedinec bought the Beckett place and surrounding land and subdivided it into 34 to 50 acre parcels. We bought our 49 acres from him, on Co. Rd. 31. The Beckett home place had not been sold yet and I discovered that the pump was still there. After talking to Leon, he told me to take it, before something happened to it. That was 1979 or 80.

I was visiting John Allen and he said he had the glass cylinder for the top of the gas pump. The Allen Family ranch bordered the Beckett property on the west/northwest. He sold it to me and I have had it stored in my closet all this time.

It's now 2008 and finally the pump has been restored. I took it completely apart and sanded all the old paint off. Many parts were ordered from a couple of antique parts dealers. Once the entire pump was sanded, Ken Myer painted all the parts for me. The base is blue, body white and top red.

The pump is operational and hopefully I will get a tank installed and attach the pump. However, we may never be able to afford the gas.

This was a labor of love and I have met several people with the same interests and made some new friends.

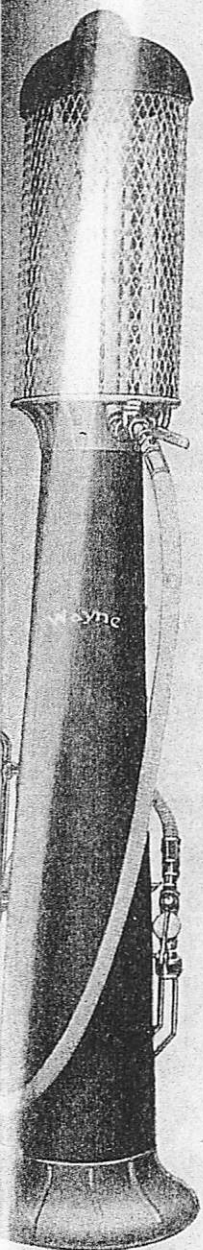

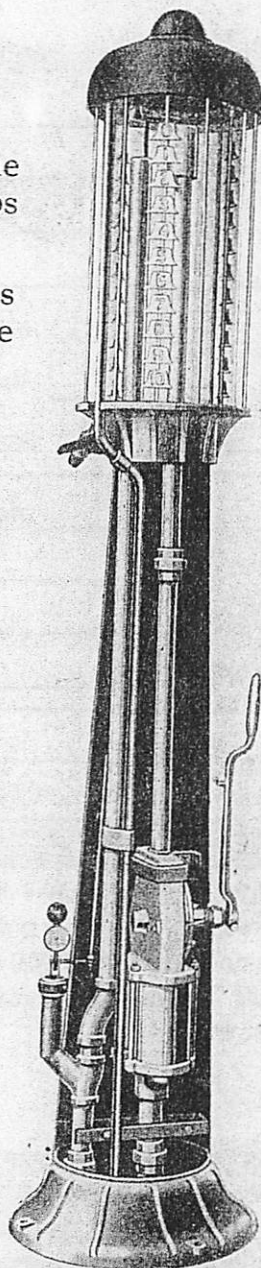
