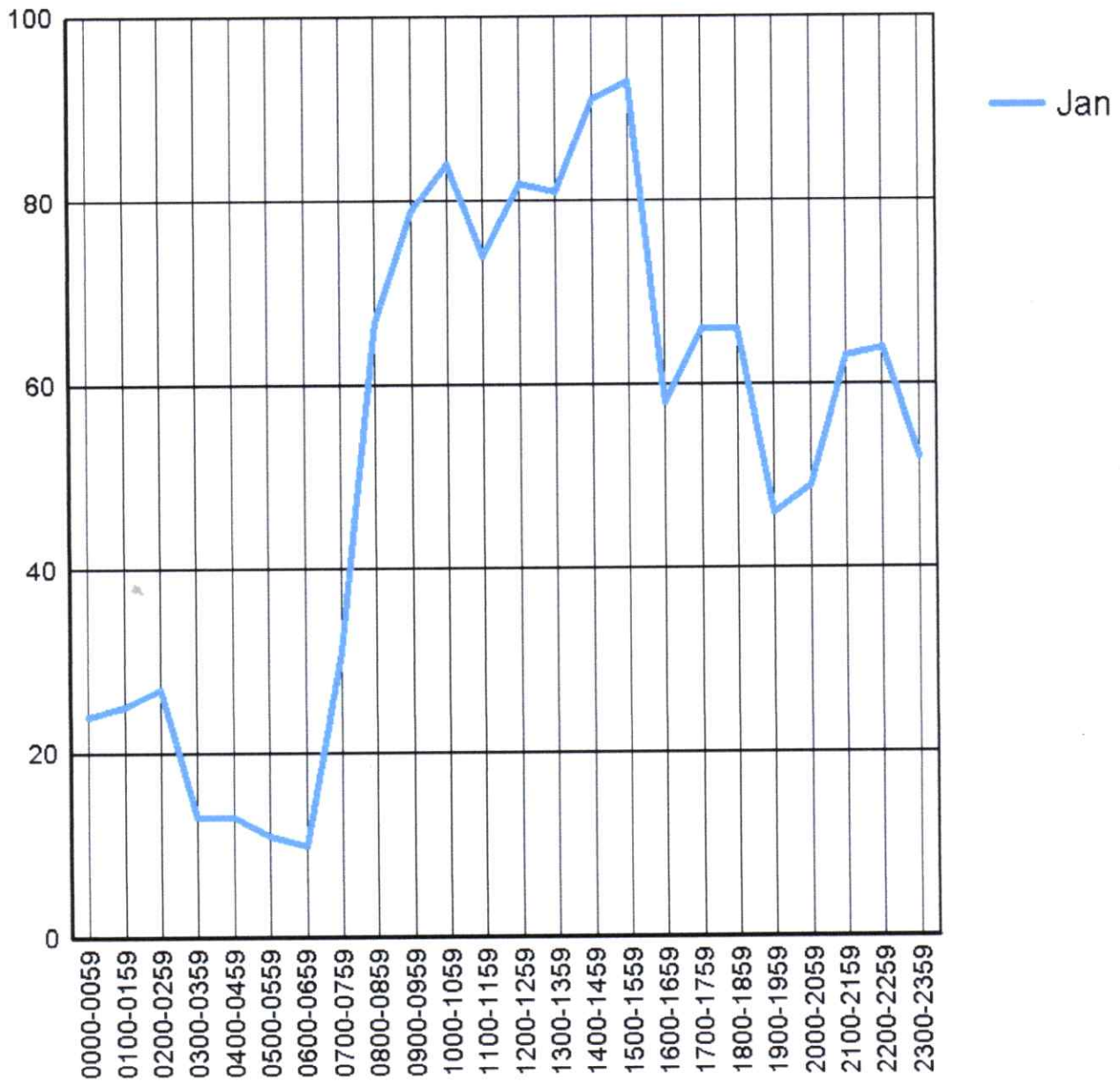

Community Profile

Craig is a smaller community of approximately 9,268 (as of 2023) residents in Northwest Colorado. Craig has seen steady but small growth in population over the last few years. Craig is the county seat of Moffat County and also serves as the central business and economic hub for the northwest Colorado region. In addition, Craig also serves as a bedroom community to the Steamboat Springs area, with many of the resort community's employees residing in and near Craig. There is one school district in Moffat County, with all but one of the district's schools being located within the city limits. The police department and the school district have a current IGA in which the school district pays for one full-time SRO.

There are several nearby attractions for outdoor enthusiasts, including world class hunting, and several state parks and reservoirs in the vicinity.

Department Profile

The Craig Police Department has an annual budget of approximately \$4.2 million dollars, with 22 sworn staff and 7 civilian staff members. Craig relies on the Colorado State Patrol, Craig Regional Communications Center for all radio communications and 911 operations. The Craig Police Department includes the specialized functions SRO, K9, Investigations, a multijurisdictional Special Response Team (SWAT), and a multijurisdictional drug / major crimes task force within the department. Additionally, the department houses a code enforcement / animal control team.

Pre-Assessment Review

Craig submitted its application for accreditation in May of 2023; however, no assessors were available at the time. In October of 2023, I was assigned as the sole assessor and began coordinating with Craig PD to receive accreditation materials from them. I completed a site visit to the Craig Police Department on December 4th, 2023 .

On Site Review

The assessor visited Craig PD on December 4th, 2023 and conducted the on-site inspection. Chief Cochran escorted the assessor through the department which is located within a shared complex. Craig PD is part of the Moffat County Public Safety Complex which houses Moffat County Sheriff's Office, Moffat County Office of Emergency Management, Colorado State Patrol, and the Colorado State Patrol Regional Communications Center.

The property/evidence facility was not accessible for inspection, as the evidence technician was not on shift at the time of my site visit. I did observe that the outside door was secure and managed by a digital access system; Craig PD manages property and evidence for both their police department and for the Moffat County Sheriff's Office. The assessor inspected a marked patrol unit; Craig PD has recently changed the design of their patrol car stripes and presently have two different designs (old and new) on the patrol cars as they phase out one design and implement their new style markings. All patrol units are clearly marked and were found to be well equipped and in good working order. After review, it was confirmed that Craig PD is in compliance with the formal standard requirements as laid out by CACP.

Post Assessment Review

Relevant notes and observations were used to complete this report for the CACP Professional Standards Committee. Chief Cochran and his staff assisted with additional information for this process.

Summary

The Craig Police Department is a well managed, professional agency. The staff displayed high morale and pride in the agency while the assessor was present. The citizens of Craig should have high confidence in the quality of services provided. Based on the findings of the assessor visit and extensive review of all documentation, it is recommended that the Craig Police Department be approved for accreditation.

The Final Assessment Worksheet is not included with this report, as Craig PD utilizes PowerDMS for their accreditation management. PowerDMS does not allow CACP assessors to print assessment worksheets. However, the final report with the recommendation and signatures of the assessors is included with this report.
