

RESOLUTION No. 7 (2024)

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE GENERAL FUND-
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR THE EPA BROWNFIELDS GRANT

WHEREAS, the City Charter (Art. VII, Sec. 14) provides for the appropriating of excess revenues exceeding budget estimates for expenditures during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted the 2024 Annual Appropriation Ordinance #1149; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$300,000 Brownfields grant in 2021 from the Environmental Protection agency with \$9,000 remaining in the EPA budget to close out the grant

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous to modify and amend the 2024 Budget to provide \$9,000 in remaining funds to complete the Brownfields grant in the General fund; and

AND WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Craig, Colorado that the unrestricted and unappropriated excess revenues in the General Fund in the amount of \$9,000 from the Environmental Projection Agency are hereby appropriated and shall be made available for said purposes, and that the 2024 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is amended in the General Fund - Economic Development (10-52-96004) account is increased from \$300,000 to \$309,000.
