

## COUNCIL MEETING JUNE 11, 2024 MINUTES

Mayor Pro Tem Derek Duran brought to order at 6:30 p.m. the first regular meeting of the Craig City Council for the month of June 2024. In addition to Mayor Pro Tem Duran, those present were Councilmembers Nathan Butler, Jesse Jackson, Randy Looper, Andrea Camp and Luke Tucker.
