RESOLUTION NO. 18 (2024)

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CRAIG AND MOFFAT COUNTY FOR THE 2024 COORDINATED ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Craig and the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder have entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for 2024 Coordinated Election that outlines the responsibilities of the Moffat County Clerk and the City of Craig. The agreement outlines the tasks to be performed by the City of Craig and the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder to conduct the 2024 Coordinated Election.

WHEREAS, the agreement outlines the cost allocation associated with the 2024 Coordinated Election between the City of Craig and the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder. The parties agree the minimum cost for election services related to the 2024 Coordinated Election will be \$500.00. The costs borne by the City will be proportionate based upon the County expenditures relative to the Election and the number of eligible electors per Entity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in the City of Craig, in the County of Moffat that the City Council approves the Intergovernmental Agreement for 2024 Coordinated Election and authorizes the City Clerk to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City of Craig.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this Resolution shall take effect upon adoption, shall be authenticated and shall be numbered and recorded in the official records of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if any provision of this Resolution or the application of it to any person or circumstances is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications. The provisions of this resolution are expressly declared to be severable.
