

RECYCLERS ARE FACING TOUGH ECONOMIC TIMES

Craig's Recycling Facility is Slated to Close

Higher processing costs and lower commodity prices are making life difficult to the industry. Jamie Gormley is the Business Development Manager for Centennial Recycling in the metro Denver area and he says, "this is the most difficult I have ever seen the market." When he says the market is difficult, he is including the great depression, when commodity prices plummeted for recycled materials.

Apparently, the industry does not have a clear path after the biggest buyer of recycled materials produced in the U.S., China, has pulled back their purchases of plastic and fiber. The industry just got too dependent on China for this market according to Juri Freeman, a senior consultant with RRS.

Just to provide a few examples, over the past year the value of cardboard has dropped close to 70%, aluminum is down over 30% and plastics range from 30% to 50% lower.

Recyclers face tough economics

Prices for cardboard, which accounts for 40 percent of the mix at Alpine Waste and Recycling, the state's largest recycler, are down 68 percent over the past year. At the same time, processing costs have risen as recyclers try to meet higher purity requirements from buyers of materials.



Contamination in the recycle streams has become a major factor and purity standards are affecting costs along with increased processing costs which have escalated dramatically. Not long ago the City would transport loads to Milner and there were no tipping fees associated with the load. Our cost-of-delivery was in mileage, transportation, labor and overhead costs like insurance. Today the tipping fees have climbed to \$79/ton and the contamination fee is calculated at an additional \$62/ton. Unfortunately, many of our loads are contaminated according to the contamination standards of the facility and in many cases are being rejected.

The industry is changing, but not going away. Processing recyclable materials is becoming a service industry like the landfill. This means that processing costs will need to be bore by the generator, or to put it more succinctly, by the individual business or household.

The City of Craig will continue to monitor the situation and look for ways to efficiently participate in recycling. In the meantime, we will discontinue the mixed paper, cardboard, and co-mingled recycling program until further notice. The recycle drop-off location at 1775 Yampa Avenue will close except for

the onsite used oil receptacles as they city will continue to accept clean, used oil. Recyclers will need to find other avenues to transport and pay for their recyclables until a better solution is determined.
