Participate in the Colorado Public Utilities Commission's PUBLIC COMMENT HEARINGS

on Xcel Energy's Just Transition Solicitation

The PUC invites community members to provide comments regarding Xcel Energy's Just Transition Plan (JTS), Proceeding 24A-0442E. The JTS is Xcel Energy's next Electric Resource Plan to address the acquisition of new utility resources to meet future electricity needs on its system. The primary objectives of th JTS include fulfilling resource adequacy and providing reliable service; continuing progress on emissions reductions; and, delivering a just transition in communities where generation assets are retiring. Xcel Energy's Unit 3 coal-fired facility in Pueblo will retire no later than Jan. 1, 2031, and coal-fired facilities in Craig and Hayden are set to retire in 2027 and 2028.
