ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING DESOTO TRASH CARTS

With the disbursement of the new trash and recycling bins almost complete, the city has received numerous questions about the process for picking up old trash bins and using the new trash bins starting June 1. To assist you, a graphic is included that provides clear directions on how to prepare your old trash cans for collection. If you have any further questions or need additional assistance, please call the Action Center at DeSoto City Hall. City staff is here to ensure a smooth transition for everyone.



If you were renting a blue recycle cart from Republic, please place that cart out empty on Wednesdays (recycling day), and Republic’s cart removal team will be working through the city to remove, through the end of June. If Republic does not remove it by the end of the day on Wednesday, please place it out each Wednesday until it’s gone.

***These are recycle carts without the label on the lid.**



If you were part of the pilot program years ago and have a green DeSoto cart, and you want to get rid of it, place it out on any of your trash days starting June 3, and Republic Services will remove it.



Customer-owned Containers will no longer be serviced starting June 3. If you would like Republic Services to remove your own cart, please place the **empty** old cart out next to the new bins on trash day.

What do you do with old Customer-Owned Containers?

Here are 3 Options:

- 1) Keep for storage
- 2) Place out next to trash cart or in trash cart for Republic Services to remove
- 3) Place in new Recycle cart to be removed
