Submittal Requirements:

Application form (completed and signed)

Evidence of site visit by City official

Site Plan which shows:

- Property lines
- Existing structures on site and on adjacent lots
- Location of fenced enclosure
- Location of coop within fenced enclosure
- Dimensions of fenced enclosure and coop
- Distance of fenced enclosure from property lines, structures, and houses on adjacent lots

Enclosure requirements:

- In back yard only
- Not in a critical area or buffer, set back from bodies of water, set back 100' from wells
- Minimum 15' from all property lines
- Minimum 20' from neighbors dwelling units
- Minimum 5' from any other structure including decks
- Must be fully enclosed with a sturdy fence of adequate height in order to protect the chickens, contain the chickens, and prevent access by predators/dogs, both from digging under the fence and jumping over the fence
- At least 4 sq. ft. per chicken; 120 square feet is the maximum size

Coop requirements:

- Must be within enclosure
- Minimum 5' from all structures, including decks
- Maximum height = 8'
- Maximum area = 120 sq. ft.
- Solid roof, walls and door (door must be latched at night)
