

Fence Requirements for Residentially Zoned Property



- 1. Submit two copies of the plat of survey, indicating location, material and height of proposed fence along with a completed fence permit application.
- 2. The Community Development Department will review and approve.
- 3. Fences constructed on easements are subject to removal by Utility Company or the City of Elmhurst for access purposes. The Utility Companies and the City of Elmhurst are NOT required to fix or replace damaged or removed fencing.
- 4. Corner lots are subject to special review and approval by the Zoning Department.
- 5. A fence may not exceed 3 feet in height with in 10 feet of the intersection of an alley or sidewalk.
- 6. A fence may not exceed 3 feet in height within 5 feet of the intersection of a driveway and sidewalk.
- **Corner lots are subject to special review and different codes. Approval needs to be made from the Zoning Department**
- ** A 4' high fence is allowed provided that such fence is 75% open and must not be chain link. Line of sight requirements must be verified**

Line of sight requirements apply to alleys and driveways for any fence over 3 feet
