3. Traffic Surveys:
 - a. SURVEY #1 LOCATION: Old Post Road at/between Post Road and Library Parking Entrance

NATURE OF REQUEST:

The library is asking for three (3) 1-Hour (9-8 PM) "Library Only" and one (1) "Drop Off Only" (24-7) parking on the even side (Northeast) of Old Post Road, adjacent to the library, between Post Road (Route 1) and the parking lot entrance. The street is currently diagonally striped and has a sign for "Drop Off Only".

RECOMMENDATION: DENY Request due to roadway width restrictions and Bicycle Route.

- b. SURVEY #2 LOCATION: Redding Road at/between 1261 Redding Road and Hulls Farm Road

NATURE OF REQUEST:

In an effort to increase road safety with pedestrians and bicycles on Redding Road, requesting the installation of the MUTCD compliant Vehicular and Traffic Warning Signs W11-15* to be posted along the length of both NB and SB approaches with minimal areas of refuge for pedestrian and bicycle traffic.

RECOMMENDATION: Install W11-15 signs in the following locations: Redding Road at 335 Redding Road in both N/B and S/B directions, Redding Road north of the driveway at 735 Redding Rd on the Northbound Side, and at the same location on the Southbound Side of Redding Rd south of the driveway to #918 Redding Road and the southbound lane directly across. Redding Road between #1268-1310 Redding Road and southbound south of #1261 driveway.

- c. SURVEY #3 LOCATION: Reef Road at/between Post Road and existing No Parking Here To Corner Sign

NATURE OF REQUEST:

The Southbound Lane of Reef Road at Post Road is posted "No Parking Here to Corner". Suggest to change sign to:

"No Parking Here to Corner Tow Away" along with adding hash marks designate the No Parking area.

BY WHOM: Lt. Michael Paris

RECOMMENDATION: Install Tow Away Zone Sign to bottom of existing 'No Parking Here to Corner' Sign. Install hash marks on the roadway from the 'No Parking Here to Corner Sign' to Post Road. Discuss option to install plastic flexible bollards in roadway similar to the bollards installed in the City of New Haven – Town Engineer, B. Hurley
