2. Adley Road at/between Lloyd Drive
3. Unquowa Place at/between Bank of America and #41 Unquowa Place
4. North Benson and Post Road, Westbound Lanes

**SURVEY # 1 LOCATION:** Jennings Road at/between Black Rock Turnpike and Hunyadi Avenue

**NATURE OF REQUEST:**

Egress from Hunyadi Avenue onto Jennings Road is compromised by parking at the location of 468 Jennings Road. Two vans and two or three cars are frequently at this location blocking the site line of oncoming cars from Black Rock Turnpike/Jennings Road intersection. At least one van is parked at this location 12/7. In order to see oncoming (relatively fast moving) traffic one must inch out into the traveled lane and hope no vehicle is approaching.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

**SURVEY # 2 LOCATION:** Adley Road at/between Lloyd Drive

**NATURE OF REQUEST:**

Proposal by Engineering/DPW to convert a wide Y Intersection to a "T" intersection. The recommended approach would be to install stop signs on all approaches. Alternative proposal would be to switch existing stop sign from Adley to Downhill approach on LLOYD but would render Adley as a straight -thru movement. Having Stop signs for 2 out of 3 approaches is not recommended. DPW paving street in August. Also, recommend stop bars, stop ahead signs and temporary cones/markings to highlight new layout. As of 6/14/24 some residents are award of project BUT no outreach has been performed yet.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

**SURVEY # 3 LOCATION:** Unquowa Place at/between Bank of America and #41 Unquowa Place

**NATURE OF REQUEST:**

Install "No Parking Anytime" sign on Unquowa Place between Bank of America entrance/exit and #41 Unquowa Place on the West side of the roadway. Parking in this spot makes exiting difficult to see oncoming traffic and is between two driveways.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

**SURVEY # 4 LOCATION:** North Benson and Post Road, Westbound Lanes

**NATURE OF REQUEST:**

For LTA Review - Request State to cross hatch or provide smaller shoulder so ours doesn't look like a lane.
