The Annual Budget Meeting of the Town of Fairfield will be held via phone on Monday, May 2, 2022, at 8 PM for the following purposes:

1. Roll Call - Pledge of Allegiance - Moment of Silence
2. To consider and act upon self-supporting funds in the amount of \$6,884,937 for the Water Pollution Control Authority for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
3. To consider and act upon self-supporting funds in the amount of \$3,111,143 for the Emergency Communications Center for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
4. To consider and act upon self-supporting funds in the amount of \$229,066 for the Regional Fire Training School for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
5. To consider and act upon proposed appropriations in the amount of \$345,100,092 for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, as recommended by the Board of Finance, for any lawful purpose. The total proposed budget as approved by the Board of Finance is as follows:
