I write to nominate Bob Frigo for Fairfield Citizen of the year. I knew Bob for 15 years prior to his recent passing. I worked closely with him on the Library Board of Trustees for almost ten years and continued to follow his work as an advocate for Senior services, affordable housing and maintaining high quality services for our town.

In addition to being the consummate gentleman, Bob was a talented, committed and high quality volunteer for the Town. In my decade of working with him on the Board of Library Trustees, I can say without hesitation that our Town's libraries, and therefore our Town's residents, benefitted directly from his service. The Library Board of Trustees is fairly unique in that it manages a source of funding (endowment funds) separate from the budget it receives via town tax revenues. Bob was instrumental, both as a member of the Library Building Committee and as Treasurer and Chair of the Library Board of Trustees, in leveraging the relatively small endowment funds to support paying for the bonds that financed the library renovation and paying for the special materials for the library collection. No one understood that process better than Bob and all members of the Library staff and Board continued his legacy as he trained us in how to work with those funds in a responsible and conservative fashion. This was an example of Bob taking his professional training and converting it to the benefit of the Town.

While many of our citizens are happy to serve on a Board and then quietly accept retirement after "doing their duty," Bob continued to seek other ways to assist his fellow citizen in a number of ways after leaving the Library Board. He was passionate about finding ways to provide appropriate, accessible, affordable and attractive services and options for senior citizens. He was also committed to ensuring that town residents who were on fixed incomes or less able to access the various gifts our town had to offer could still benefit from all that Fairfield can provide. His passion for the Library was about providing opportunities, and he continued that need to open doors by working with the Senior Advocates.

When I think about a citizen who represents the best of what Fairfield has to offer, I think of a person who is about community, wants to continue to grow, and avoids the easy path of expecting someone else to do the work of building a better community. That is Bob Frigo. I know that our Town is better today, and will continue to prosper because of Bob's contributions; and, I know I am a better person from having Bob be a part of my life.

I am sure there are other people who may be as deserving of this honor as Bob, but I cannot imagine anyone who is MORE deserving. What makes him particularly deserving of this honor is that all that he accomplished, worked for, and attempted, he did without any interest in self-aggrandizement, need for recognition or desire for celebration. He was utterly selfless and, truly, a gift to the Town.
