IS THE CREEK BEING TESTED?

DEP has made a change to who holds the Stormwater Management Permit –
The Town will be the holders of this permit as of December 15th

WHEN WILL IT BE REDUCED TO 44FT?

JM- We can't move anything until we get permits in place, usually 90 days, then 2 months to scope the Berm, then construction – about a 5 month process once we get approval.

PATTY C? - I have a petition from a wide variety of neighborhoods , we have a lot of questions to be answered. Mike and Joe, thank you for giving us the beginnings, we're upset, we're angry. Here's an angry town.

MT If we need another session we will have it.

MT- There is no recourse. There are no performance penalties in their contract. We're taking steps going forward to tighten up the PO's based on the information received. We will establish a schedule of updates for the next 12-18 months.

MT We've focused on how to do things differently going forward
